## **AAPI - ATIP Skills Development**

#### **General Information**

#### **Broadcast in English - 2024**

Sessions Module B is 42 hours long and is spread out over a two-week period. Each day of the 7-hour course is delivered via videoconference from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with ATIP practitioners and a logistics support person in attendance

#### **Videoconference Broadcast**

In addition to the lunch period, health breaks of 15-20 minutes are inserted during the morning and the afternoon.

#### **Registration fees and teaching materials**

The registration fee is indicated on the registration form. Teaching documentation included: for each course, the participant will receive the following documentation: (1) the Instructions and Course Outline document, (2) the course workbook, (3) the workbook of exercises and operational practices, (4) the list of prior reading, if applicable, and (5) the evaluation questionnaire.

### **Program Registration | Participant Substitution**

Replacement of a participant is accepted free of charge until the beginning of the first course. No replacements are accepted once the regular program has begun.

- Between 7 and 15 business days before the start of the Program: 40% of the registration fee is due.
